Key Messages

COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE

Pfizer Bivalent (BA.4-5) 12 years + (Grey) (ancestral formulation)

The Commonwealth's supply of the **Pfizer Bivalent (BA.4-5) 12 years + (Grey)** (ancestral formulation) is close to expiry, and soon you will **no longer be able to order** this vaccine product.

From <u>Saturday 10 August 2024</u>, all sites' allocations for this vaccine type will be set to '0' in the COVID-19 Vaccination Administrative System (CVAS).

Sites who have ordered this vaccine with a Requested Delivery Date of <u>23 August 2024</u>, are reminded that these doses <u>expire on Saturday 31 August 2024 at the latest</u>.

After this time, please <u>do not administer</u> the vaccine. Sites who also have stock on hand of this vaccine are reminded to <u>check the batch expiry date</u> and <u>discard</u> any remaining stock, ensuring that it is <u>reported as wastage in CVAS</u>.

Alternative Vaccine

Sites are <u>reminded</u> that the Pfizer (XBB.1.5) 12 years+ (Grey) vaccine is available to order through the CVAS ordering tab. The maximum ordering allocations for the Pfizer (XBB.1.5) 12 years+ (Grey) vaccine changed from 600 doses to **120 doses per fortnight** on 3 August 2024. The **minimum ordering** requirement remains unchanged at <u>60 doses</u>.

Please only order what you need to meet demand.

There are more than sufficient doses of COVID-19 vaccines available to ensure everyone in Australia who are eligible for a vaccination can receive it.
